



BLT Dip Recipe

No cook needs more than a couple of really good party dips in their repertoire, but here's one you might like to consider.

Guys go for it because it's hearty. The ladies like it because it makes an attractive presentation. Everybody likes it because it's good! It's perfect for a Super Bowl Party.

Combine and refrigerate 5 – 24 hrs:

½ c. mayonnaise

1 ½ c. sour cream

½ t. garlic powder

½ t. onion powder

Remove 1 hr. before guests arrive. Add:

2 c. chopped baby arugula, stems removed

18 slices bacon, cooled and crumbled

4 tomatoes, diced fine

Serve with bread sticks, melba toasts, or crackers. The dark green of arugula and chopped red tomato give it a very fresh appeal.

Leave some tomato and arugula on top and just partially stirred in for maximum effect.




